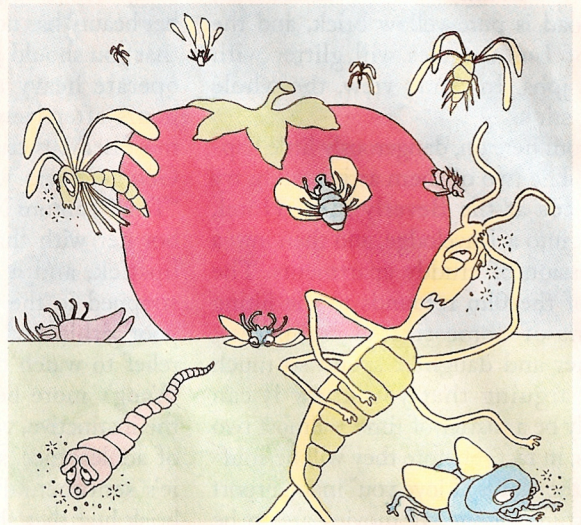


FOOD FIGHT BY GAHAN WILSON

The big corporations claim they're only helping edibles fight off bugs and other natural enemies.



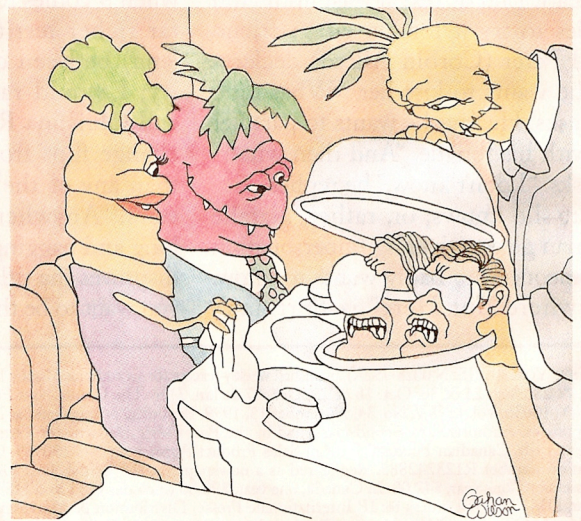
They say that consumers who worry about the use of human-genome technology suffer from overactive imaginations.
